## Call for Entries - Food Vendors

Dear Friend,

You are invited to participate in the **TROUTFEST 2009** hosted by the Little River Chapter of Trout Unlimited. **TROUTFEST Great Smoky Mountain Fly-Fishing Exposition** is being held on the Townsend Visitors Center Festival Grounds at the foothills of the Great Smoky Mountains National Park.

**TROUTFEST** outdoor activities will take place on Saturday, May 16<sup>th</sup>, 9am-6pm and on Sunday, May 17<sup>th</sup>, 10am-5 pm. This year's Troutfest incorporates a Fly Fishing Exposition which we expect to be one of the largest outdoor events in the southeast for fly anglers. National vendors will bring the latest equipment for demonstration & admiration. Fly fishing experts like Lefty Kreh, Joe Humphreys, Bob Clouser and others will have free Casting clinics and Fishing Seminars and will be available all weekend. As always Troutfest will be a fund raiser for the GSMNP and this year has the added distinction of being a GSMNP 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary event.

We need food vendors. Snacks, sandwiches, desserts, dinners, peanuts, popcorn, hot dogs and more!

Food vendor booth spaces are available for rent at a price of \$125 for a 10' x 20' space.

Booth space (10' x 20') for a Non-Profit organization is negotiable. Contact a **TROUTFEST** Chairman.

- All vendors must submit a full description of the foods to sale & an outline of their services.

- A set up of one table and two chairs will be available for rent at the price of \$10 per set. Reservation for tables and chairs must be made at time of application.
- Vendors are responsible for supplying their own tent, canopy or trailer.
- Power supply is available at all food booths. Please inform us of the number of electrical amps you require.
- Vendors will be expected to have their booths in working order by 9am each morning of the festival and remain open until the end of the festival hours each day.
- The Health Department requires an inspection upon set up on all food booths. You will be inspected upon set up and you will be responsible for the \$30.00 fee for inspection. Payment will be due to the Health Department upon inspection.
- Due to limited space, food vendors will be chosen on a first come, first served basis.

Please fill out the attached entry form and submit it with full payment for your booth rental (check or money orders only please). Please send a self addressed stamped envelope for the return of any samples you would like returned. If for some reason you are not chosen, your payment will be returned.
